

SMOKE FREE ENVIRONMENT POLICY

RATIONALE

The Oratia District School Board of Trustees is committed to complying with the Smoke-free Environments Amendment Act 2003 and with the Health and Safety Environments legislation.

PURPOSES

1. To be pro-active in achieving and maintaining a healthy and safe environment for all employees and all other people using our school.
2. To prevent detrimental effects of smoking on the health of any non-smoking person whilst in the work environment.

GUIDELINES

1. Smoking is prohibited in the grounds and buildings of the school at all times.
2. Any person can complain to the board if they believe that there has been a contravention of the Act.
3. The board will follow procedures to deal with any complaint as set out in the Smoke Free Environment Amendment Act, 2003.
